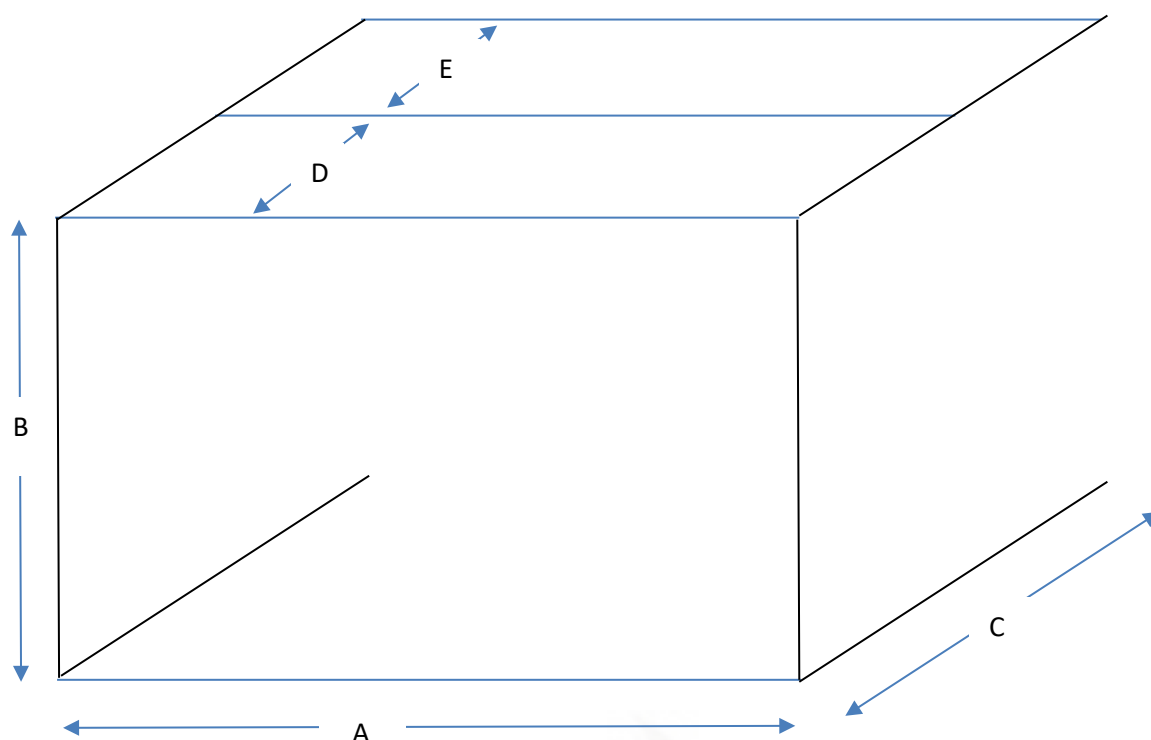


## How to measure your brick fireplace for a frame and glass door/s

Please measure at least at 3 positions each and give us the smallest and largest measurements.					

- Would you prefer a flat frame or a frame with a return-lip (usually 20 mm)?

Very important: Take note of the following.

- DO NOT deduct ANYTHING from measurements. Leave that to us.
- Are there any lintels / beams protruding out from the fireplace opening? If yes, by how much?
- Is your fireplace directly in a corner of the room? If yes: left, or right?
- Now, take a clear photo of the fireplace and close surroundings, - we can zoom in, but we cannot zoom out - to make sure that we have all the relevant info we need. We regularly see something that you could not know was important. Rather send too many pics, than not enough of the right ones.
